### Education Malaysia – Partners Conference 2018

If all documents submitted are complete and it complies with the requirements, a Visa Approval Letter (VAL) will be issued within 14 working days from EMGS. With the VAL, the students can enter Malaysia or apply online for a Single Entry-Visa.
