Try to mingle with the locals and start conversations whenever you can with your neighbours, shopkeepers or even the taxi driver.



Compared to other Asian countries, English is widely spoken in Malaysia. A moderate command of English is enough to get you around. If you're venturing beyond the major cities, learn a few words of Bahasa Malaysia, Chinese or Tamil for a better chance of connecting with the locals.

GET AWAY TO THE HIGHLANDS!

At about 1,500 metres above sea level, Cameron Highlands, Pahang – located only four hours away from Kuala Lumpur is set along a mountain plateau high above the river valley. Temperatures on this hillside fluctuate between 22° and 25° Celsius during the day and between 15° and 22° Celsius at night, making it easier than in the lowlands to jungle trek, camp and picnic.
